Several female members of the Sculptor's Society Gold Coast Inc conceived a vision of bringing a diverse range of women artists together for support and promotion of women's art in three events [\(see info flier attached for event details and contacts\)](#) all opening on the same day - the 8th of March 2011 which is the 100th year anniversary of International Women's Day. We are seeking expressions of interest from female artists in all media to exhibit art by women and about women - a female aesthetic dealing with women's issues, or a celebration of the diversity and achievements in women's art.

Robina Community Art Gallery was established to showcase the diversity of arts practice in the area, and every day between 800 and 900 customers pass through the doors of the Robina Centre, Gallery and Library complex. **Robina Community Art Gallery** will host 'FEMME' – an exhibition showcasing the art of female artists in all media. We invite you to enter the 'FEMME' exhibition with your Submission Of Interest. Entries are subject to a selection process due to availability of space.

KEY DATES for 'FEMME' - Robina Community Art Gallery:

1. Submissions Of Interest due by 15th of February 2011 – firm, no late entries accepted. Submit via Email to corinne@doktor-frock.com
2. Artists selected for exhibition will be notified via email by 22nd February 2011.
3. Delivery of selected art work to Robina Community Art Gallery strictly Tue 8th March 2011 from 9am to 11am FIRM as the exhibition MUST be hung prior to opening the SAME afternoon.
4. Opening Afternoon Tea 2pm-3pm - International Women's Day - Tuesday 8th March. Join us for a celebration at the exhibition. Exhibitors kindly requested to bring a plate of finger-food to add to the buffet and festivity.
5. Collection of art work strictly Monday 21st march 2011, 9am -noon firm.

Gallery Open to public during library hours Mon - Sun.

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY - 'FEMME' - Robina Community Art Gallery:

1. We are seeking art work by women that depicts women in a positive light, but does not have to be images of the female form - a basket, textile art or ceramics made with skill and care can also display this ideal. All media is acceptable, including textiles, ceramics, sculpture, photography, painting etc.
2. Entrants must be able to adhere to strict bump in and bump out times.
3. Entries must not be too large in size due to space limitations. We suggest no more than around 60X60cm for either 2D or 3D entries . Limit of 3 artworks for submission for possible selection.
4. Submission Of Interest must include the information requested in the Submission Template below and 1 labeled image of each art work emailed as a .jpg picture.
IMPORTANT - please do not submit more than 3 images and keep the size DOWN to compressed .jpg images of less than 1MB per image.
5. Submissions Of Interest must be received by 15th of February 2011 with a limit of 3 artworks submitted for possible selection per artist.
6. Artists selected for exhibition will be asked to pay \$10 per artist (inclusive of up to 3 possible artworks selected) to allow for quality advertising, promotion of artists and related exhibition costs incurred. This entry fee will be paid in cash on delivery day with artwork to the venue, with receipts issued for your records.
7. The gallery is not staffed or manned, **and the responsibility for your artwork lies solely with yourself** - however, we may request each artist to help with a 4hr roster session to man the exhibition during the 2 week exhibition, which is an opportunity to promote your work and contribute to the benefit of the others exhibiting as well.
8. Artworks delivered to the venue must be labeled with **Artist's Name, Title Of Work, Medium, Price, Contact Phone Number** neatly printed on the templates provided to attach to each exhibit. Sales will be directed and go through the artist.
No commission on sales will be taken.
9. Insurance of artwork is the sole responsibility of the artist. There may be a possibility that the exhibition is not manned at some times.
10. If selected you understand that the image of your art work will be shared in various promotional tools such as websites, Facebook gallery pages that will promote International Women's Day, you and your art work.
11. Selected artists are also asked to supply three copies of an A4 artist bio or CV, which has your contact details which will be displayed in booklets located in and the Robina Community Art Gallery and at 19Karen Gallery during the exhibition to promote you and your art practice. **Deliver this with your artwork on delivery day.**
12. Thank you and remember there are three events opening on International Women's Day 8th of March 2011. We suggest you submit your work for both exhibitions using the correct Templates provided. Check out Sculptors' Society Gold Coast Inc and Gaggle Womens Art Group on Facebook to add your support and we hope that you'll be joining us in one of them.
