Workshop wreaths will exhibit on 8 March 2011 at the Southport Broadwater on the water edge near the bait shop, Smith St turnoff.

Start 9am to finish 11am. Bring a camera. The *forget me knots* series of art works is ephemeral but the lasting archival work is a photograph image. Plus professional video for viewing. The exhibition is a one day memorial event for *all the women held against their will*, and is an important contribution to international women's day events.

Some wreaths may be exhibited at the *Robina Community Gallery*. The choice is yours.

The wreaths will be created by a group of women artists under the guidance of *doktor frock* (corinne colbert), a local artist /teacher.

The artworks, in the form of ephemeral wreaths, will float on *International Womens Day 2011* and be filmed for various international and national websites.

The workshop will explore the female aesthetic.

Bring a plate for morning tea.

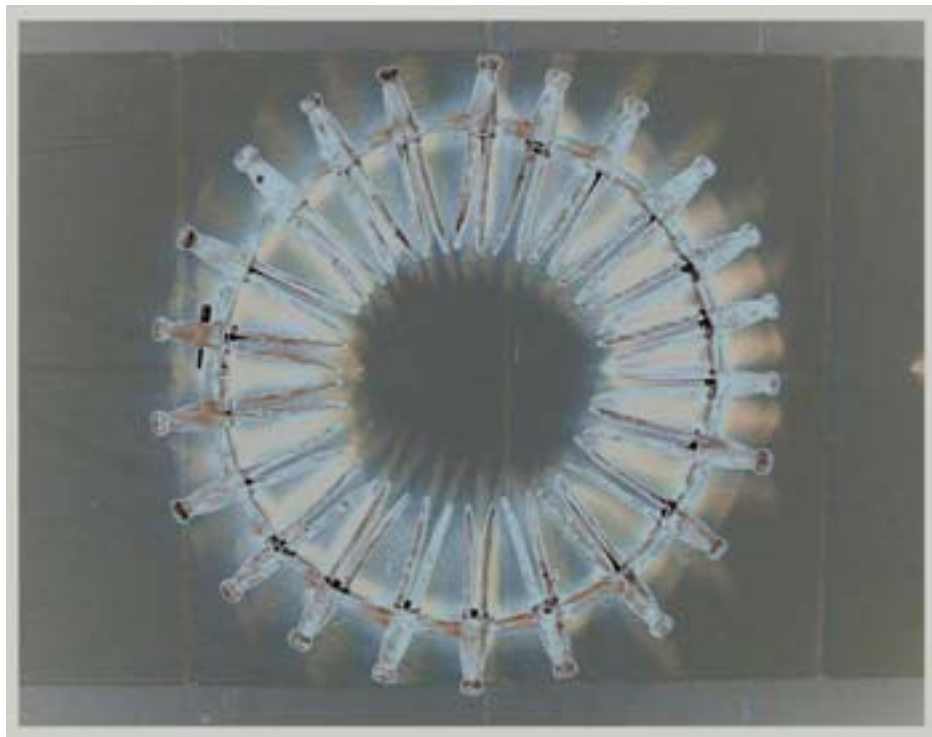
This project is conceived by Corinne Colbert and is part of three events planned with Midge Johansen.
